Each Lent, we especially focus on three ways, we can all strengthen our preparation for Easter; through prayer, fasting and almsgiving (fundraising). Today is CAFOD Family Fast Day and we have discussed with our children how they can fast in a small but meaningful way. Today or over the weekend, they may choose to go without a treat/part of a treat to recognise fasting. In this small way of abstaining, they are recognising what so many people suffer across the world and are also developing their understanding of Jesus' temptation in the desert. We are planning a number of charity/almsgiving activities which we will share on a separate specific letter with parents and carers. Prayer remains a fundamental aspect of our daily lives in school, we often call it our ongoing 'conversation' with God. Each week during Lent we will share a prayer which you may share at home with your child/children to support their Lenten journey and your family pray life.

World Book Day Competition


Your child will be bringing home a paper plate with their World Book Day voucher soon.
