Rag Bag Textile Recycling

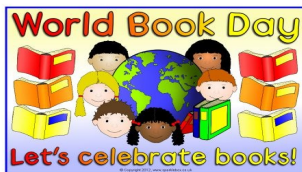
Thank you for the recent contributions for our textile recycling.
