We will have a final communion meeting for parents and carers after school on Thursday 5th June in the school hall.

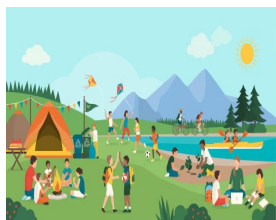
School breaks up today for half term.
