The Table

A refugee filled with depression, I put my rucksack on the table.

To keep my children beside me in the hug I let go.

I put my own hand in, choking me and my voice disappearing; I was forced to do things I didn't want to.

Bribed with money, but I couldn't risk it.

The thought of seeing my child, my wife, dead or alive and my house that's gone.

I put in there things that happened in my mind. I put in there my child growing up, taller than me, even.

I put there my wife cooking for me—even though I'm not there.

Telling my boy sweet words... "Daddy is coming home. Tomorrow, is another day."

I stood by the table and it shattered to pieces.

With all the heavy burdens I carried, to start a new life, one with a new table.
