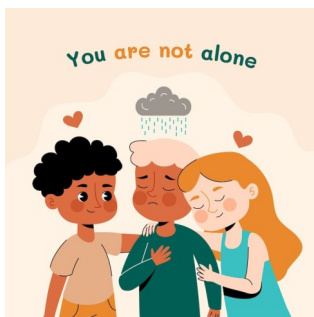
Oscott College, Birmingham

encouraging our children to feel a sense of belonging, and supporting children to value and nurture the inclusion of others.

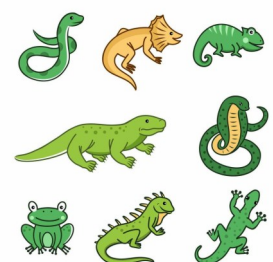
NSPCC Number Day!
