Courage Story Writing School of Sanctuary

As part of our continuing work for schools of Sanctuary, and to enhance our children's understanding of the challenges and barriers that refugees often face, we are taking part in a Coventry Writing competition. The Coventry Ethnic Minority and Achievement Service (EMAS) are challenging Coventry children to write a story based on 'Courage' - a time when you or a character/someone else has had to show courage when seeking sanctuary and safety. Our children may wish to write one or two story entries. If your child would like to write a story at home we request they bring it into school by **Friday 22nd May** with their name, class and our school name written on the entry.

Selected stories will be chosen by the EMAS team and displayed in Coventry City Centre.

Amen.

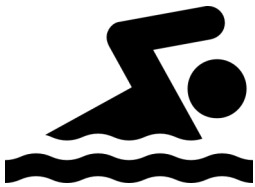


Coventry Junior PCSO'S
