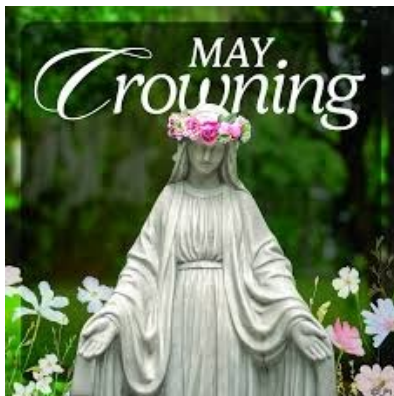

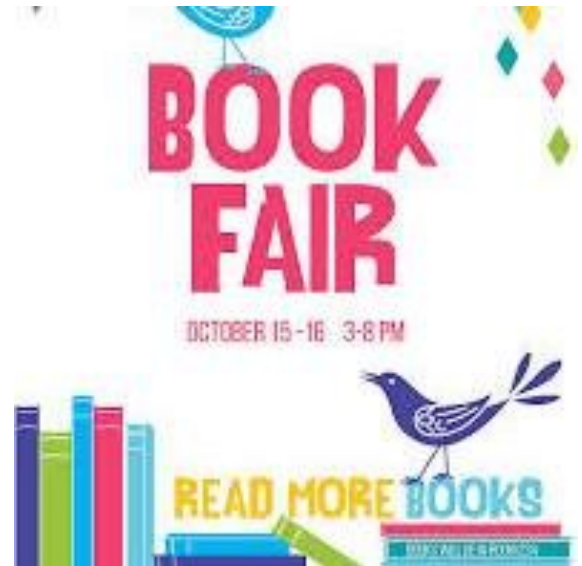

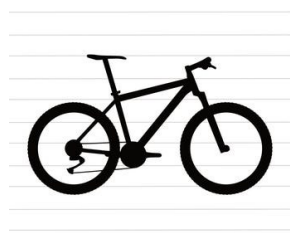
Bookfair
