That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.





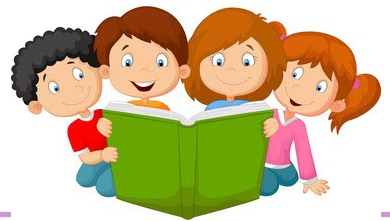
Simply repeating, 'Come Holy Spirit' is a great prayer to say at Pentecost, and also each day through the year.
